ALTERNATIVE RECREATION POLICIES

Pick up/Drop off Policy

All activities are closely supervised and staff is scheduled according to the individual needs of the program. Participants should not be dropped off early and must be picked up promptly. We strictly enforce District policy against transporting participants home. Any participant not picked up within 30 minutes of the conclusion of an activity may be released into the custody of the Simi Valley Police Department. The reoccurrence of late pick-up may be grounds for exclusion from future participation.

INFORMATIONAL CORNER

- Participants who may require assistance with toileting matters, need to inform the Alt. Rec. staff before registering and participating in any activity or program.
- The District unfortunately cannot provide wheelchairs at this time. Participants must provide their own if needed.
